

Directions to Bob and Liz Blasko's Home

Rt. 22 East to 25th street exit in Easton, Pa. Make a right at the end of the ramp. Follow directions from step #1.

Rt. 22 West to 25th street exit in Easton, Pa. Make a left at the end of the ramp. Go under Rt. 22. Follow directions from step # 1.

Rt. 248 south into Easton, Pa. Go under Rt. 22. Follow directions from step #1.

Rt. 78 East to Easton exit. Make a right. Go to light and make a right onto Industrial Drive. Follow about 1 mile to stop sign. Make a right onto Morvale Road. Go ¼ mile to stop sign. Make a right. Go ¼ mile and make a left onto Island Park Road. Follow directions from step #2.

Rt. 78 West to Easton exit. Make a left at the end of ramp. Go over Rt. 78 to the light and make a right onto Industrial Drive. Follow about 1 mile to stop sign. Make a right onto Morvale Road. Go ¼ mile to stop sign. Make a right. Go ¼ mile and make a left onto Island Park Road. Follow directions from step #2.

1.) Go past Easton High School, which will be on your right. Go up a slight incline to the traffic light at the intersection of William Penn Highway. Go through this light and proceed to the next light, which will be at the intersection of Freemansburg Avenue. Go through this light. About ½ mile further you will cross the Glendon bridge, which is over the Lehigh river. Make a right at the stop sign at the end of the bridge. Go about ¼ mile, down over a knoll and make the first right onto Island Park Road.

2.) This road will pass Air Products chemical co. on the left. About four miles further, as you climb a gradual incline, you will pass the Northampton County SPCA. It will also be on your left. Just past the SPCA the road makes a slight bend to the left. There is a green direction sign on the right with the mileage to Hellertown and Bethlehem. Make a right at this sign.

3.) Travel down a slight decline and wind down under Rt. 78. You will go past several farm houses on the left, which set back off of the road. About ¼ mile further down the road, you will pass several houses on the right. Next will be two dirt driveways and then a paved driveway. Make a left into the paved driveway. The address is posted on the mailbox as 2510 Redington Road.
