FAQ's

- Q. How much do we need to raise and how long do we have to raise the amount?
- A: The Greater Impact Campaign's first goal is to pay off the existing mortgage and obligations about \$830,000. This alone will free as much as \$120,000 per year in payments that can be used towards expanded ministries and some towards facility expansion. The second goal will be to have cash available to begin site work on the property. Our overall base goal for the campaign is \$1,500,000 with a stretch goal of \$2,000,000. The capital campaign will be conducted over a three-year period.

Q. How much do we expect to borrow?

A: Before we even consider how much we will borrow, we need to first pay off the existing mortgage and other obligations, and have cash on hand to start work on the new property. The eventual mortgage on the new facility, if needed, will not be more than the church body can handle.
