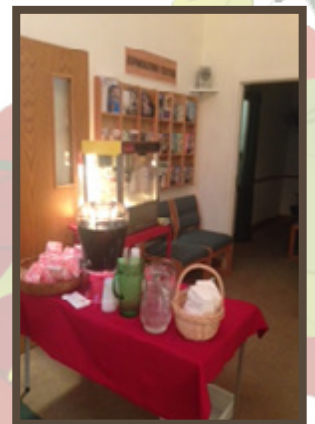


with an expressed overall enthusiasm towards the Greater Impact advance commitment phase of the campaign. Praise God!

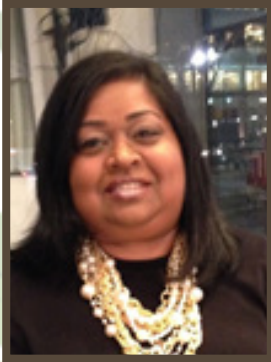

FAQ's


Q. How much do we expect to borrow?

A: Before we even consider how much we will borrow, we need to first pay off the existing mortgage and other obligations, and have cash on hand to start work on the new property. The eventual mortgage on the new facility, if needed, will not be more than the church body can handle.

Q. How much do we need to raise and how long do we have to raise the amount?

A: The Greater Impact Campaign's first goal is to pay off the existing mortgage and obligations - about \$830,000. This alone will free as much as \$120,000 per year in payments that can be used towards expanded ministries and some towards facility expansion. The second goal will be to have cash available to begin site work on the property. Our overall base goal for the campaign is \$1,500,000 with a stretch goal of \$2,000,000. The capital campaign will be conducted over a three-year period.

I Chronicles 28-29 provide the biblical example for special giving projects



- **The Vision:** King David announced the vision God had given him for building the temple.
- **His Commitment:** He announced what he was generously committing to give, over and above his regular giving, toward this Kingdom project.
- **The Invitation:** He invited his leaders and all people to consecrate themselves and give as well.
- **The Commitment of all:** Following David's example, they gave willingly and generously toward the temple project.

29:14- "But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand."
